'There are so many opportunities to get involved and take an active role in the college community. I was a student VIP and led the Fundraising Team, I also took part in the Team Mathematics Challenge at Keele University.'  
Matthew collected 2 A\* grades in Further Maths and Maths and 2 A grades in Physics and Computing A Levels. Matthew leaves us to continue studying Mathematics and Physics at Sheffield University.

- Over 800 students gained passes at Advanced Level
- 36 A level subjects with 100% pass rates with 27 achieving over 95% pass rates
- Well over a third gained grades A-B with two thirds gaining grades A-C
- Over 90% of our students achieved the grades they need to progress to university
- 50 talented students passed the equivalent of three subjects with grade A. 10 achieved four A grades. This year students gained nearly 550 Grades A or B with over two thirds of the grades achieved by students being either A, B or C
- Outstanding performance of all minority ethnic students who all achieved 100% pass rates at A Level
- Over 745 students completed their study of a range of vocational qualifications at Levels 1, 2 and 3
- Over one third of students on BTEC Level 3 (Certificate and Diplomas) courses gained a double distinction (DD)
- Cai Brown, formerly of Trentham High School, led the male success stories as they continue to close the gap with females. Cai collected 4 phenomenal A\* grades



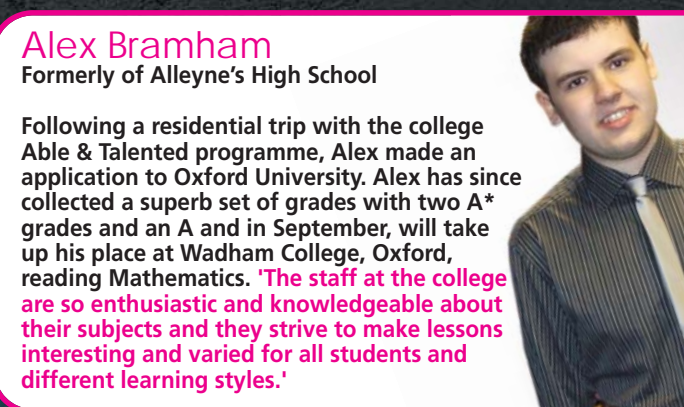
**Mia Harris**
