TASKS

TASK1: CREATE A MOODBOARD OF IMAGES YOU HAVE TAKEN OVER THE SUMMER. TAKE AT LEAST 30 PHOTOGRAPHS. THESE IMAGES SHOULD DEMONSTRATE A VARIETY OF SUBJECTS AND PERSONAL APPROACHES TO PHOTOGRAPHY. YOU CAN PHOTOGRAPH ANYTHING BUT THE IMAGES MUST BE YOUR OWN AND SHOW YOUR CREATIVE AND UNIQUE APPROACH TO PHOTOGRAPHING THE WORLD AROUND YOU. (LIST OF SUBJECT IDEAS)

TASK 2: USING THE RESEARCH TABLE. LOOK AT A VARIETY OF PHOTOGRAPHERS THAT CREATE WORK IN YOUR PREFERRED GENRE. SELECT THREE AND CREATE THREE RESEARCH PAGES FOLLOWING THE TEMPLATES.

TASK 3: USING ANY EDITING SOFTWARE YOU HAVE ACCESS TO, CREATE AT LEAST 3 EDITED MANIPULATIONS OF YOUR OWN PHOTOGRAPHS YOU HAVE TAKEN. CAN YOU HIGHLIGHT THE FORMAL ELEMENTS IN YOUR IMAGES?

TASK 4 - EXTENDED: RESEARCH AND IDENTIFY FORMAL ELEMENTS IN 3 OF YOUR OWN IMAGES.
