

GUIDANCE ON REPLACEMENT EXAM CERTIFICATES

All the subjects listed and the related exam boards are post-Curriculum 2000. Unfortunately, we do not have any information of the exam boards prior to this date.

Exam boards do not issue replacement certificates but you can apply for a certified statement of results. These are accepted by educational institutions and employers. It lists your subjects and grades as shown on your original certificate. It can take up to 28 working days to process your application and there will be associated fees.
