





Have you struggled at school, perhaps lacking in confidence, but have the commitment and ambition to succeed? Maybe you have been previously home-schooled and need formal qualifications? Our Level 3 Foundation Programme will give you the qualifications and skills you need to progress.

#### SPORTS TRANSITION

The Sports Transition Programme of study is designed to develop the skills, experience and knowledge required to progress onto a level 3 qualification in sport such as BTEC Sport and Exercise Science, BTEC Sports Coaching and Development as well as A Level Physical Education.

This is a flexible programme of study which allows students to study a YMCA Fitness Instructing qualification alongside two or three other GCSE or equivalent qualifications.
